Four of these were from the low flight which contained only five aircraft at the time, and two were from the high flight, which contained three aircraft. During these attacks number 43-38181 was seen with 20 mm shells bursting around #1 and #2 engines. What happened to this aircraft subsequently is not known.

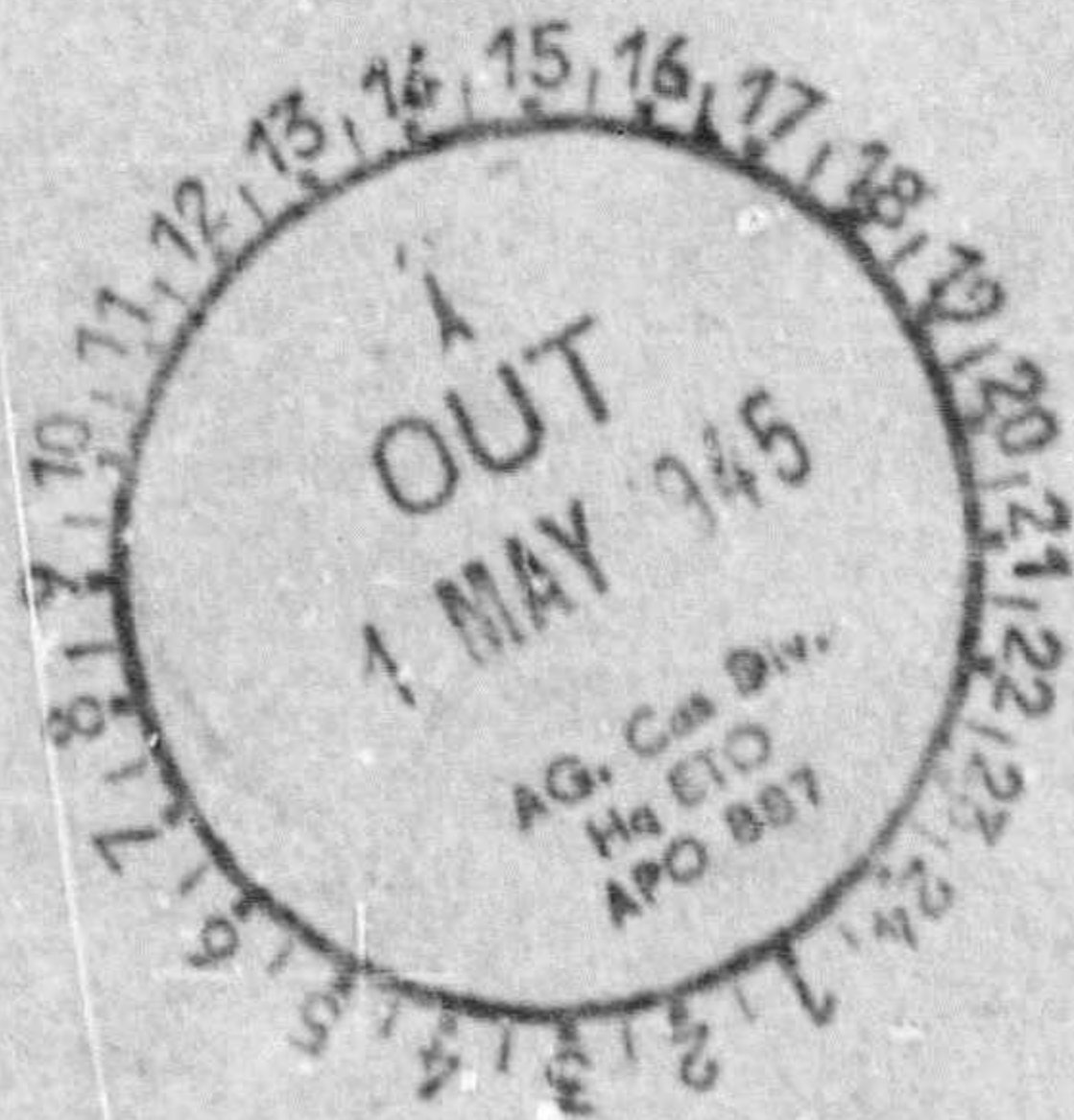

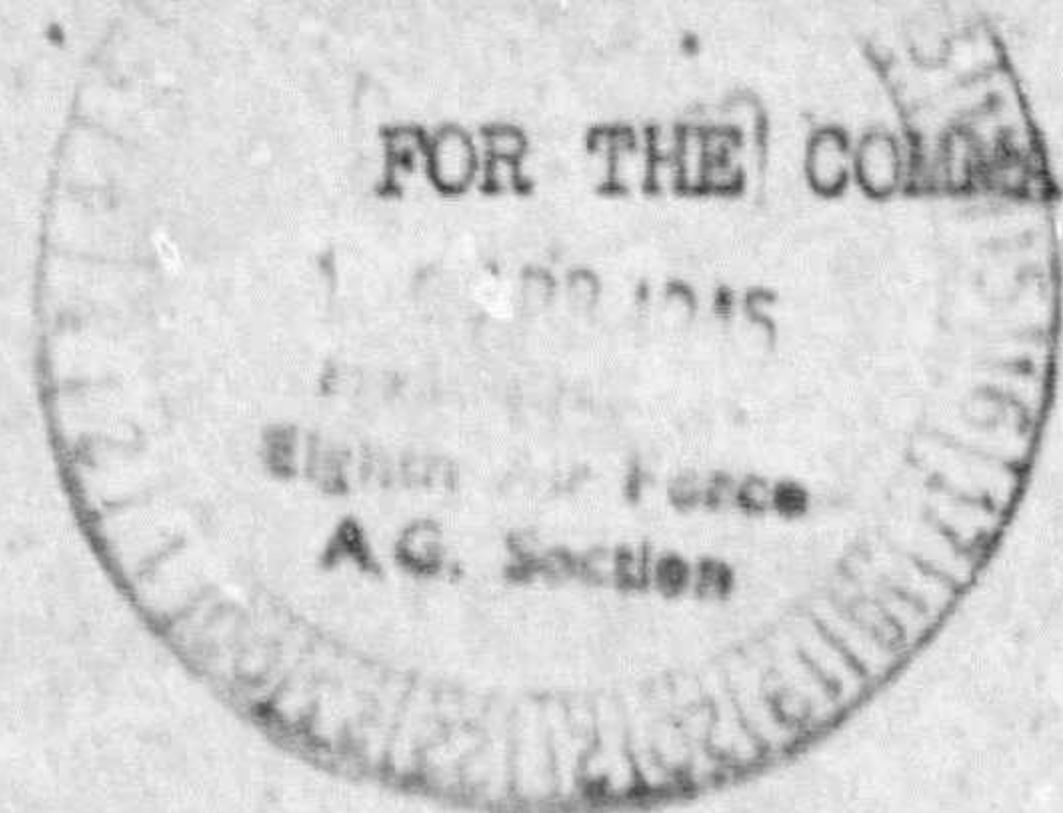

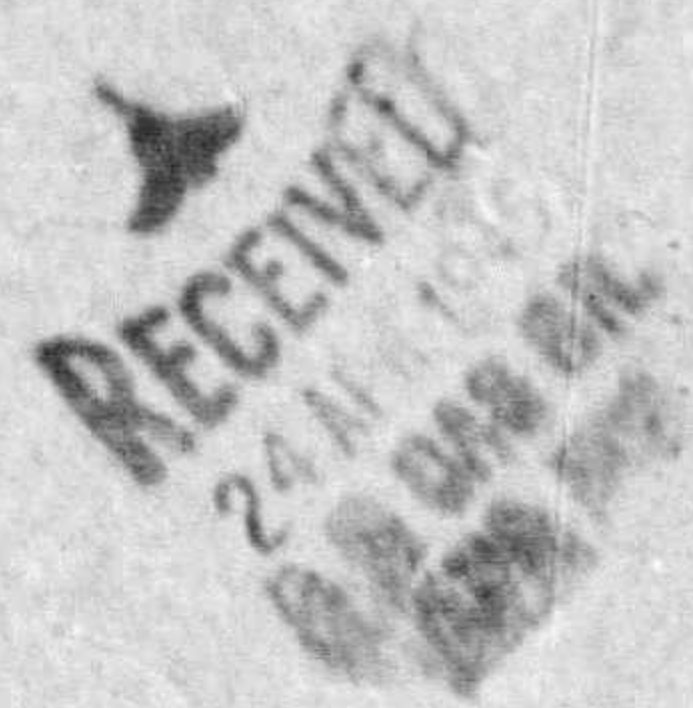
